

Baby Bunny Quilt

14" x 14" Miniature Quilt

The perfect miniature quilt for a doll, table topper, wall decoration or a pillow cover. Choose your favorite tiny print and make several just for fun! You'll find so many uses for this miniature quilt. Make extra blocks and use them for Christmas ornaments, package decorations, or even tiny pincushions.

You will need the following materials:

Fabric A, center square: 1 fat eighth or fat quarter. The print should be small and fit into a $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ " finished square. If you plan on making ornaments or pincushion use a fat quarter so you can pick and choose from the print.

Fabric B: 12" x 12" pink dot with white background

Fabric C: 1 fat quarter pink check (also used as bias binding)

Inner border: $\frac{1}{8}$ yard

Outer border: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

Backing: 1 fat quarter

Binding: $\frac{1}{4}$ yard if not using check

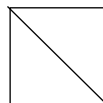
Cutting Instructions:

Square in a square block:

- Center squares: from small print, fussy-cut 9 squares $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ ". Make sure motif is centered in the square before you cut! (Tip: place center of motif at the $\frac{7}{8}$ " mark on your ruler)
- From pink & white dot cut 9 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "; cut each square in half diagonally in both directions



- From pink check cut 18 squares $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $2\frac{1}{8}$ "; cut each square in half in one direction.



Inner border:

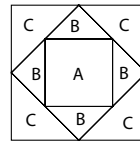
Cut 4 strips $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 8"; Cut 4 posts $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $1\frac{3}{4}$ "

Outer border:

Cut 4 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "; cut 4 posts $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

Backing: Cut 18" x 18"

Binding: Cut 2 strips $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x width of fabric, or for bias binding, cut and piece enough $2\frac{1}{4}$ " bias for 72".

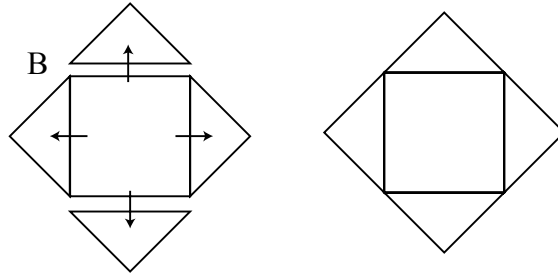


QUILT INSTRUCTIONS:
All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ "
Finished block size $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ "

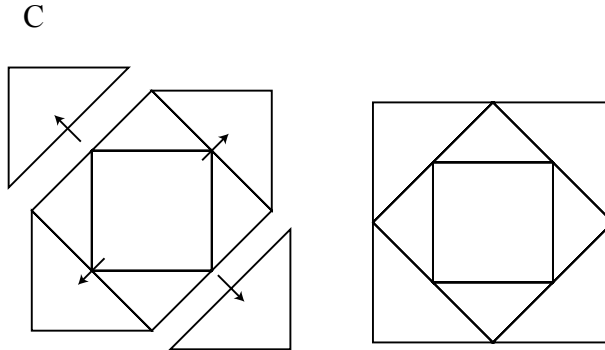
Block Assembly: Instructions are for one block, repeat for 9 blocks total

Tip: To find center of center square and triangles, fold in half and finger press fold.

Stitch one triangle of fabric B to each side of center square. Press seams towards triangles. Square should measure $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{4}$ "



Stitch one triangle of fabric C to each side of above unit. Press seams towards triangles. Square should measure 3" x 3".



Quilt Assembly:

Sew blocks together in 3 rows of 3 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Press seams in direction of arrows. Center section should measure 8" x 8".

Sew inner borders to sides of quilt. Press toward border.
Sew corner squares to top and bottom inner border. Press towards border.
Sew top and bottom inner borders to quilt.

Sew outer borders to sides of quilt. Press toward border.
Sew corner squares to top and bottom outer border. Press towards border.
Sew top and bottom outer borders to quilt.

Layer, baste and quilt as desired.

Bind using your favorite method.



To make ornaments, sew extra blocks & cut backing 3" square. Place right sides together and stitch around block leaving a $\frac{3}{4}$ " opening on side for turning. Use hemostats or tweezers for turning. Slip stitch opening closed and attach ribbon for hanging with $\frac{1}{4}$ " button.
