



Beary Bears

Featuring "Beary Boys and Girls" Flannel by Henry Glass Fabrics and Bunny Hill Designs

Tiny little 7" bears that are so much fun to make and give!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

1 skein DMC brown embroidery floss
Two 8" x 10" pieces of soft flannel & scraps for ears
Tiny bit of stuffing
12" ribbon (optional)



SEWING DIRECTIONS:

1. Place bear fabric right sides together and pin pattern to wrong side of fabric.
2. Cut out fabric and pattern on solid line. Cut out 2 bear bodies and 4 ears.
3. Trace eyes, nose and mouth onto bear front. Embroider using a tiny back stitch and 2 strands of embroidery floss.
4. Reduce your stitch length on your sewing machine between 1.5 to 2.0. (The smaller stitch length makes for smoother curves.) Place 2 ears together and stitch on - - - line leaving bottom of ear open. Back stitch at beginning and end. Repeat for second ear.
5. Turn ears right side out. Make a pleat at the bottom of ear between marks, and pin in place.
6. With right sides together, pin bear front to bear back, inserting ears at marks. (Ears face in towards the center of the bear and the raw edges are even with the seam allowance.) Sew around bear leaving open between marks on pattern. Back stitch at beginning and end.
7. Turn bear right side out, and gently poke out curves.
8. Stuff bear lightly and slip stitch opening closed.
9. Tie a bow at neck if desired.
10. Give your new little Beary Bear a hug!

Beary Bear Pattern

Sew on - - - - line, cut out on _____ line

Make a small pleat
between marks on ear

Cut 4

Insert Ears between marks.
Ears will face in towards
center of bear face.

Cut 2

Leave open between marks for turning
and stuffing
