My Sweet Baby

All strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning the project.

Materials

- 1 yard pink dot (1568-22)
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yard pink sheep (1565-21)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard green check (1569-60)
- $\frac{3}{8}$ yard EACH of: pink check (1569-20), pink floral (1571-20), yellow hearts (1566-44)
- $\frac{1}{4}$ yard EACH of: green sheep (1565-63), blue sheep (1565-15), blue cats 1567-01), blue floral (1571-50), pink hearts (1566-22), pink birds (1570-02), and green dot (1568-66)

Cutting

From the pink dot, cut:

One $7\frac{1}{4}$ " strip; recut into four squares $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Cut each $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square in half on both diagonals to make four triangles



One $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Five $2\frac{1}{4}$ " strips for the binding.

Four 2" strips for the inner border.

From the pink sheep, cut:

Four $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for the outer border.

One $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

From the green check, cut:

One $7\frac{1}{4}$ " strip; recut into four squares $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Cut each $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square in half on both diagonals to make four triangles



One $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

From EACH of the pink check and pink floral, cut:

One $7\frac{1}{4}$ " strip; recut each strip into four squares $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Cut each $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square in half on both diagonals to make four triangles



From the yellow hearts, cut:

One $3\frac{7}{8}$ " strip; recut into eight squares $3\frac{7}{8}$ " x $3\frac{7}{8}$ ". Cut each square in half on the diagonal to make two triangles.



One $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

From EACH of the green sheep, blue sheep, and blue cats, cut:

One $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

From EACH of the pink hearts and blue floral, cut:

One $4\frac{3}{4}$ " strip; recut each strip into two squares $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $4\frac{3}{4}$ ".

From the pink birds, cut:

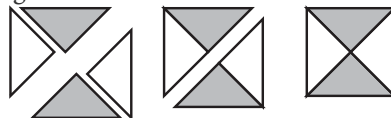
One $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

From the green dot, cut:

One 2" strip; recut into four squares 2" x 2".

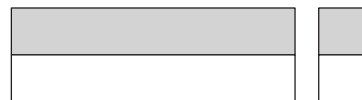
Construction



1. Sew two pink check and two pink floral triangles together as shown to make one block. Make eight.



2. Sew two green check and two pink dot triangles together as shown above to make one block. Make seven.
3. Using the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide, sew the blocks from steps 1 and 2 into five rows of three blocks each. Make certain that each type of block is placed and rotated exactly as shown.

4. Sew the five rows of blocks together to complete the body of the quilt top.
5. Make three different strip sets. Sewing lengthwise, join a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " pink sheep strip to a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow hearts strip. Join a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " green sheep strip to a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " green check strip. Join a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue sheep strip to a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue cat strip. Press all seams toward the sheep strips. Cut each strip set into twelve $3\frac{1}{2}$ " wide segments as shown.



6. Sew two identical strip set segments together as shown to complete one four-patch block. Make five pink and yellow blocks, six green blocks, and five blue blocks.

7. Sew a $3\frac{7}{8}$ " yellow hearts triangle to each side of each $4\frac{3}{4}$ " pink hearts and blue floral square as shown to make the diamond blocks. Press the seams toward the triangles.
- 
8. Using the quilt pictured on the cover as a guide, sew five of the four patch blocks from step 6 together to make one side border. Make two. Sew one unit to the left-hand side and one to the right-hand side of the quilt top.
 9. Sew three of the four patch blocks from step 6 and two of the diamond blocks from step 7 together as pictured in the quilt on the cover. Make two. Sew one unit to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top.
 10. Trim the selvages from the 2" pink dot strips. Sew the strips together end to end to make a long 2" strip. From this strip, cut two pieces 2" x 42 1/2" and two pieces 2" x 33 1/2". Sew one longer piece to the left-hand and one to the right-hand side of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border strips. Sew a 2" green dot square to each end of each shorter pink dot piece. Press the seams toward the pink pieces. Sew one unit to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border strips.
 11. Trim the selvages from the 4 1/2" pink sheep strips. Sew the strips together end to end to make a long 4 1/2" strip. From this long strip, cut two pieces 4 1/2" x 45 1/2" and two pieces 41 1/2". Sew a longer piece to the left-hand and one to the right-hand of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the border pieces.
 12. Sew a 2 1/2" pink bird strip to a 2 1/2" pink dot strip. Press the seam toward the pink dot strip. From this strip set, cut eight 2 1/2" wide segments. Sew two segments together to make one four patch unit. Sew one of these units to each end of each shorter pink sheep strip. Press the seams toward the sheep strips. Sew one unit to the top and one to the bottom of the quilt top.
 13. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.
 14. Trim the completed quilt and bind using the 2 1/4" pink dot strips.
